


How To Use CET's Trip Planner

If you have a question about planning a trip or riding the bus, you can call CET's information line at 541-385-8680. You will need to have exact change to ride the bus. You can also purchase bus tickets from CET's website: http://cascadeseasttransit.com/shop/ If you are riding to or from anywhere outside of Bend, you will need to purchase a multi-zone ticket.


If you are riding the bus for the first time, let your driver know where you are going. They will help you make sure you get to the right stop. If you will be transferring buses at Hawthorne Station in Bend, they can help you figure out where to go and which bus to board.

Start by going to www.cascadeseasttransit.com







The Trip Planner is displayed on the home page. Type the address of the start of your trip (your home, workplace, etc) and your destination. In this example, we will plan a trip from Sisters City Hall (520 E Cascade Ave in Sisters) to the St. Charles Hospital in Bend (2500 NE Neff Road). Let's pretend that we need to be at St. Charles by 8:30AM for an appointment. In the picture below, you can see what the trip planner looks like when you fill in your trip information. Next, click the blue rectangle that says "GET DIRECTIONS".



After you click the blue rectangle, a new page will open in Google Maps.



This page shows you a map and a schedule of your trip. There is a lot of information on this page, so the next page includes a breakdown of your trip details.
